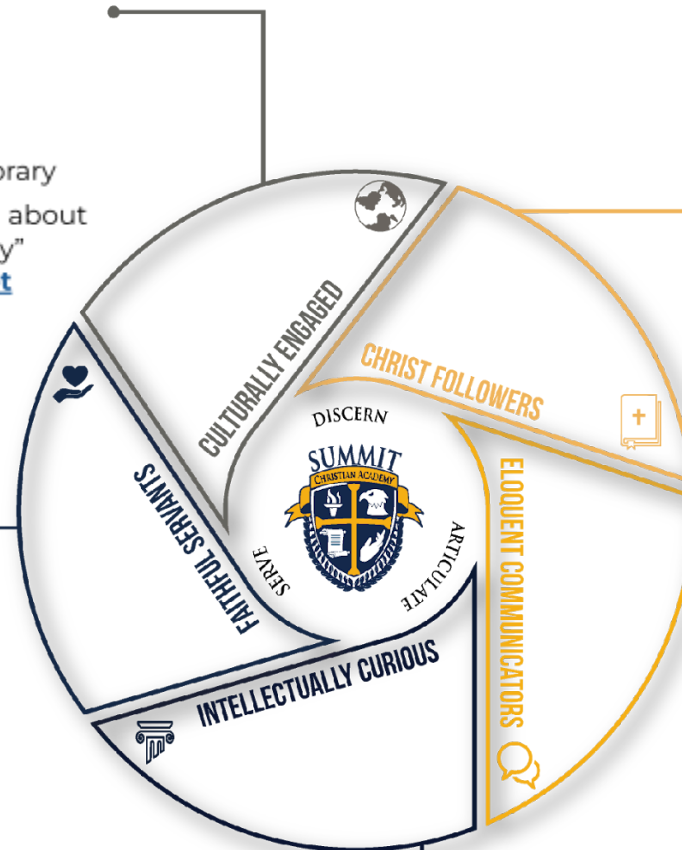
## *Summer Challenge*
